Studio Rules & Regulation Updates

- 1. It is **REALLY** important that all dancers are entering through the **BACK DOOR** of the building <u>NOT</u> the front entrance
- 2. The back room area must be **TREATED WITH RESPECT** from students especially during breaks. Students have been extremely rough with items in the back area including climbing on the furniture.
- 3. Students and families must be **CLEANING UP** after themselves especially after eating in the back area, please do not leave garbage and food around.
- 4. **PROPER DANCE** Attire, Shoes, Tights and Hair are extremely important!! All female dancers should HAVE THE PROPER ITEMS REQUIRED TO MAKE A BUN before each ballet class, all other classes students must have their hair pulled back in a ponytail.
- 5. Make sure students **UTILIZE THEIR LOCKERS** properly by leaving and dance items like shoes at the studio in their locker so they have them for class.

Health and Safety of all the Dancers

- We want everyone to know the studio will <u>NOT ALLOW</u> parents or students "Vaping" inside or near the building.
- 2. Health and safety is of the utmost importance to us and our dance family.
- 3. We also insist that if dancers are going to leave the studio during their breaks that we have written consent from their parent on file stating the parent is taking responsibility for the student once not at the studio.
- 4. If a student is planning on leaving the studio they <u>must</u> notify a teacher before they leave .This does not include when leaving with your parents. We are referring to when students leave the studio together to drive to get snacks or drinks from example Tim Hortons.
